2020-2021 Principal IP SHUN TAK Scholarship

1. Objectives

This scholarship aims to encourage students to enrich their learning experience and pursue their dreams. Through such experiences, students could explore personal potential.

2. Scholarship Coverage

This scholarship supports students' participation in academic and career related learning activities.

3. Eligibility

3.1 Secondary 3 to 5 students in 2020-2021.

3.2 Participants in academic and career related learning activities offered by post-secondary institutes.

4. Selection Criteria

4.1 Conduct: B+ or above

4.2 Academic Performance: 50% of Form Ranking or above

4.3 Non-academic Performance: Outstanding achievements in non-academic areas such as moral education, sports, music, social services or religious studies, etc.

5. Amount & Quota

5.1 This scholarship is allocated on an academic yearly basis, starting from 1 September 2020 to 31 August 2021, with a maximum of HK\$6000 in every academic year. The scholarship will be approved by the school based on fairness and reasonableness.

5.2 Each successful applicant could receive the scholarship at most once in each academic year with a maximum amount of HK\$1000.

5.3 Successful applicant could apply for other subsidies if the fee of the concerned learning activity is higher than HK\$1000.

5.4 Application will be considered on a first-come-first-served basis while funding lasts.

6. Application Procedures

6.1 Submit application form of '**2020-21 Principal IP SHUN TAK Scholarship**' with the photocopies of two latest academic reports, proof of completed application and receipt of payment to General Office within 5 working days after the submission of application to post-secondary institutes.

6.2 Upon receipt of completed application forms, applicants will be informed of the minimum subsidy individually by email within 10 working days.

7. Obligation of the Successful Applicant

7.1 The successful applicant must fulfill an attendance rate of 80% of the concerned learning activity.

7.2 The successful applicant must submit a written report in English with a 100-word self-reflection and 5-10 high resolution photos (no less than 1MB file size each) with captions featuring the learning experience. The school reserves the right to edit the report for publication.

7.3 The successful applicant may be invited to assist the school in the promotion of the scholarship (such as sharing of learning experience with other students).

8. Disbursement Procedures

8.1 Upon completion of the concerned learning activity, applicants have to submit the following documents to Miss Chu Tze Wai within 5 working days after completion of the taster programme/course.

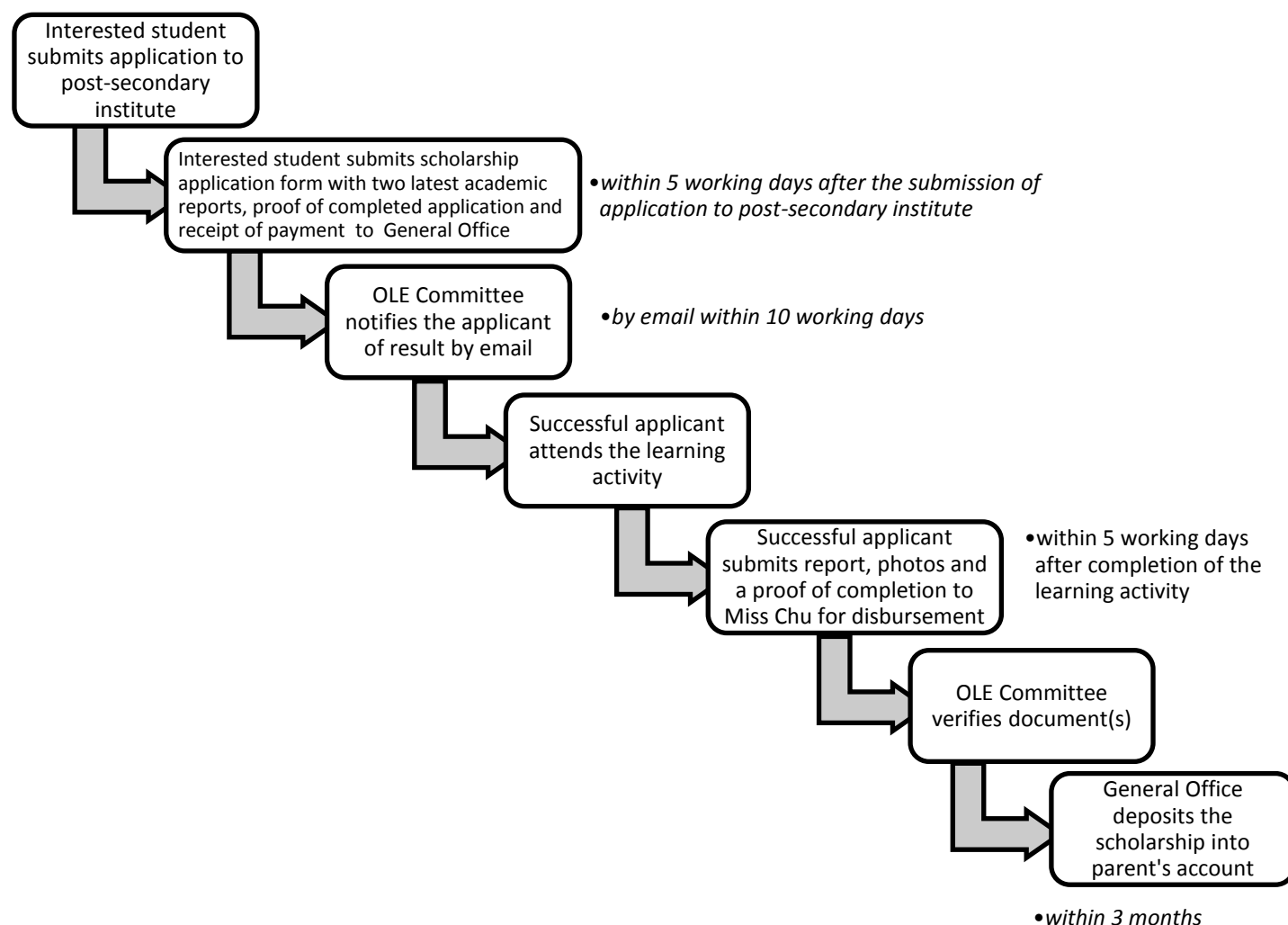
8.1.1 a proof of completing the registered taster programme / course issued by the host institute (e.g. certificate or email).

8.1.2 a written report in English with a 100-word self-reflection and 5-10 photos with captions featuring the learning experience.

8.2 Disbursement procedures that are incomplete, late or have not accompanied by the required document(s) will not be processed further.

8.3 After the above procedures are completed and the documents have been verified, the subsidy will be deposited into the bank account of the parents of the applicant within 3 months.
